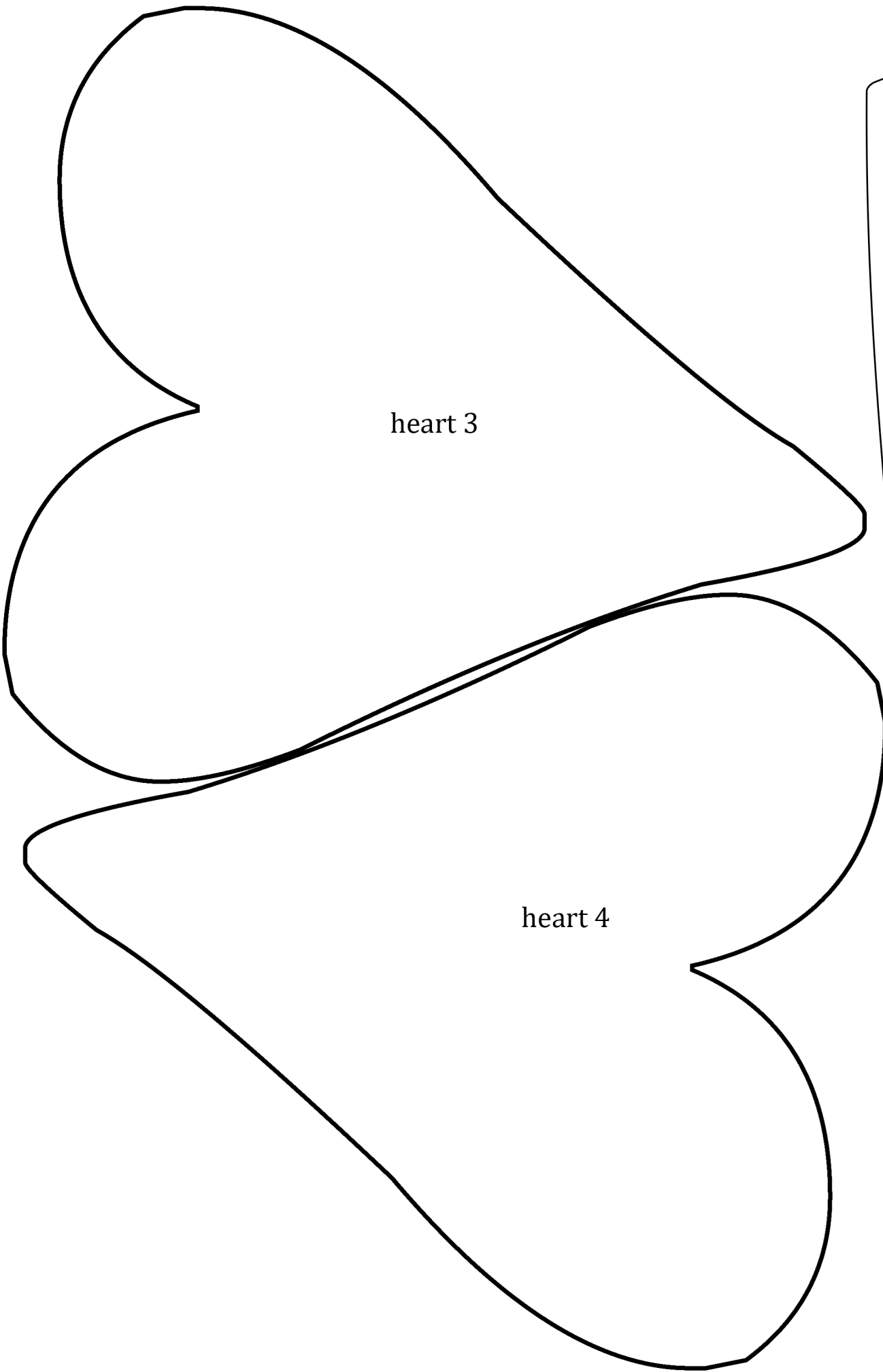
Printable Instructions

1. Print first 2 pages on Green Cardstock
2. Print last 2 pages on white or cream cardstock.
3. Cut all hearts and stem out.
4. Glue Hearts 5, 6, 7, 8 centered over hearts 1, 2, 3, 4.
5. Poke a hole through all the "o"
6. Line up hearts in order. With the stem being last.
7. Insert 1 Brad through the holes.
8. Spread it apart and it will look like a shamrock.
Line them all together and it looks like a heart.

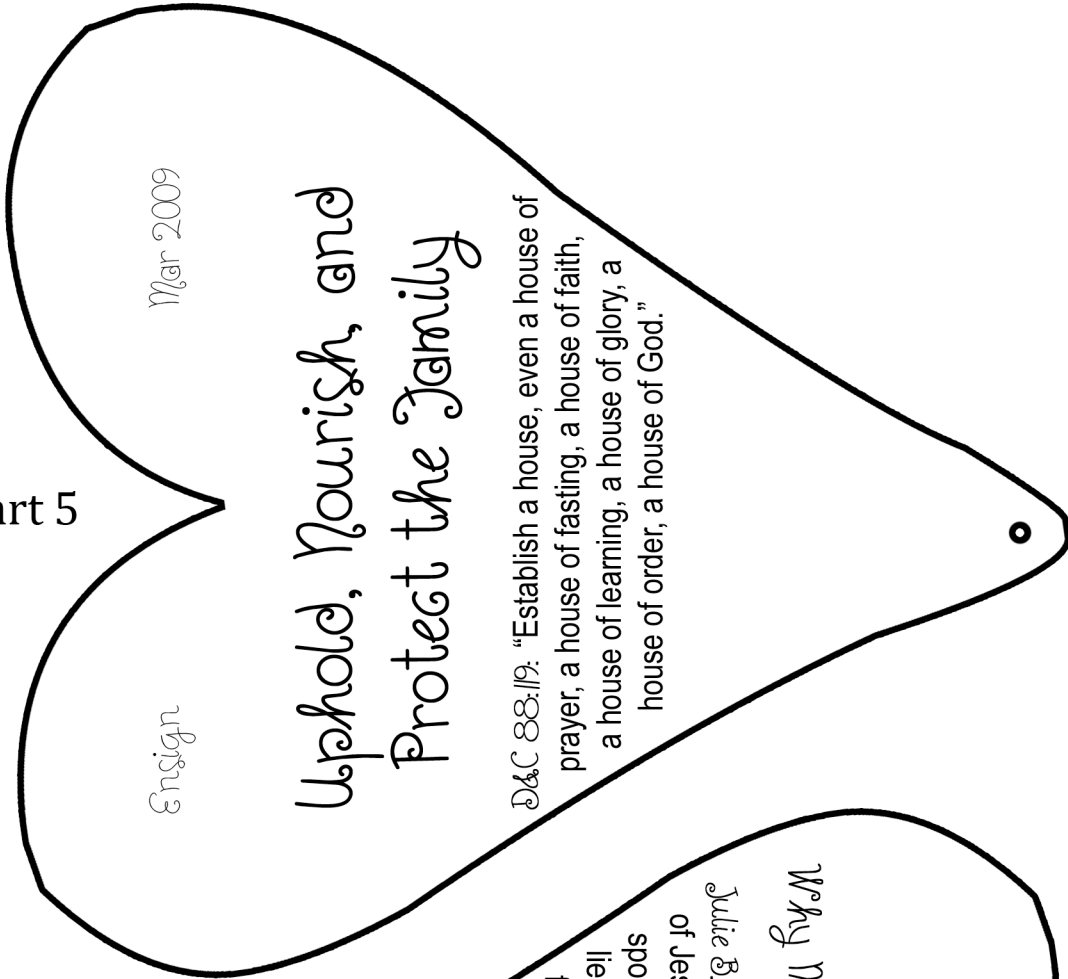

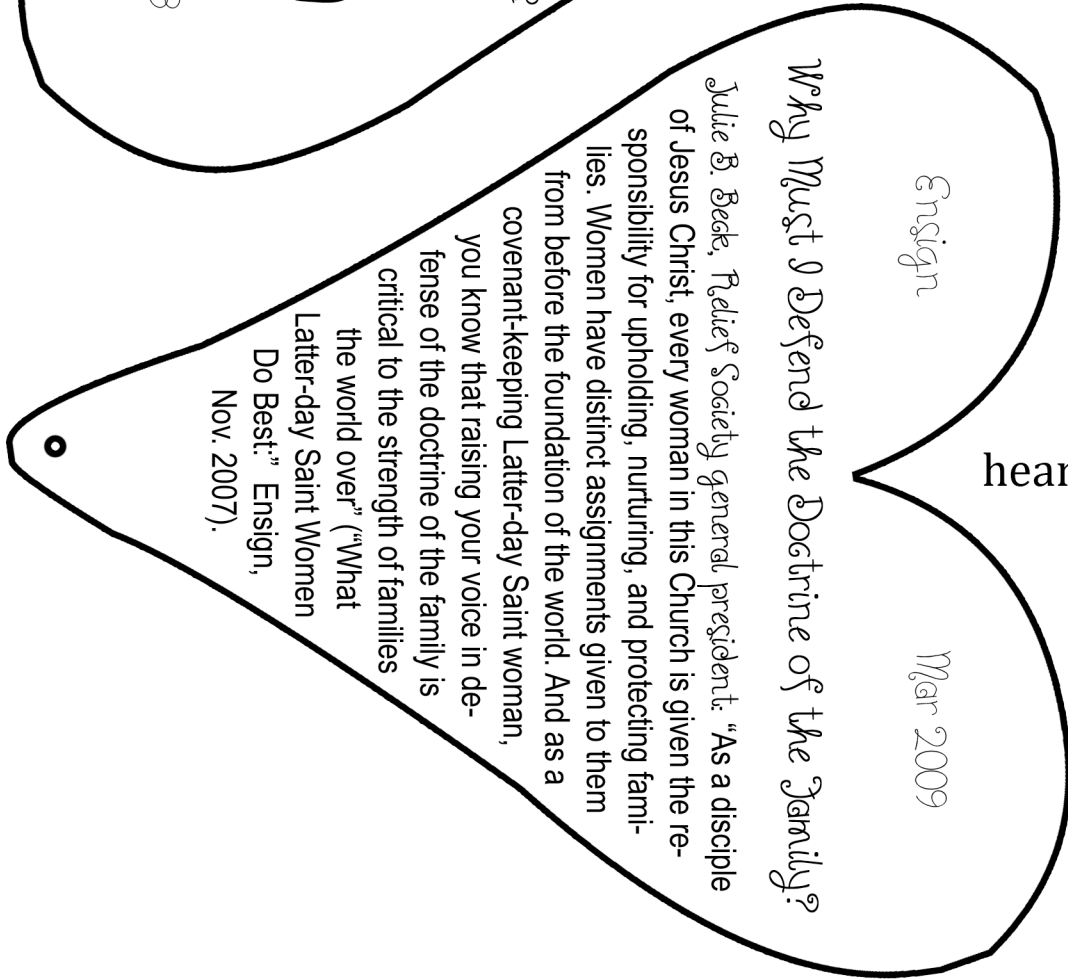

Shamrock Cupcakes

INGREDIENTS:

Cooled cupcakes (baked from your favorite recipe)

White icing

Green gum drops or spearmint leaves

Heart-shaped cookie cutter

Rolling pin

DIRECTIONS:

1. Frost a cooled cupcake (baked from your favorite recipe) with white icing.
2. For the shamrock, flatten 3 green gumdrops or spearmint leaves with a rolling pin (sprinkle on a little sugar, if necessary, to keep the candies from sticking).
3. Use a small heart-shaped cookie cutter (ours was 1 1/2 inches across) to cut a heart from each flattened leaf.
4. Place the hearts together on the cupcake to form a shamrock.
5. Cut a stem from the excess of one of the flattened candies & set it in place below the 3 hearts.
