

VisitingTeaching.net Temple Dress Instructions

1. Print dress on white cardstock, print other pages (skirts) on white/colored/patterned paper or cardstock.
2. Cut along the outside edge of dress and skirt layers.
3. Add each layer of skirt behind the full dress and staple together at the waist.

Optional Bonus Instructions:

- Print skirt pieces on colored cardstock or patterned paper, however the first page (dress) is meant to be on white cardstock because it's a Temple dress.
- Use your own ribbon and add it to the dress.
- Embellish dress as desired, keeping in mind that this is to symbolize a Temple Dress.

Gone with the Wind Cake Recipe (Angel Food Cake)

INGREDIENTS

3/4 cup water 3 egg whites 1 1/2 cups white sugar 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
1 3/4 cups cake flour 1 teaspoon baking powder 1/4 teaspoon salt 3 egg yolks

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
2. Beat cold water and egg yolks together until mixture makes 1 quart ~ at least 10 minutes. Slowly add sugar and vanilla to egg yolk mixture, beating for at least 7 minutes.
3. Sift the flour, baking powder and salt together. Fold into the egg yolk mixture.
4. Beat egg whites until stiff peaks form and fold in smoothly to the egg yolk mixture. Pour batter into an ungreased 9 or 10 inch tube pan.
5. Bake at 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) for 50 minutes. Turn upside down to cool in pan for 1 hour. Loosen sides and coax from pan.

**May be cut into layers and filled with filling and topped with whipped cream.

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
