

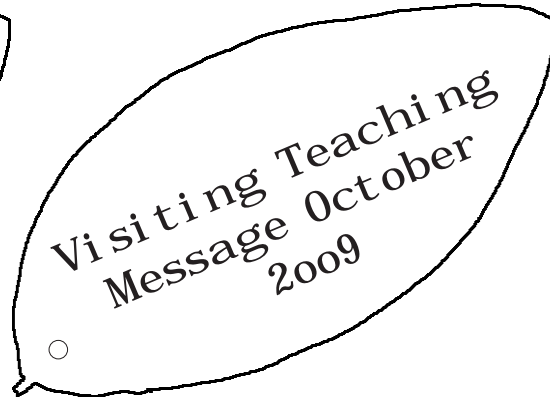
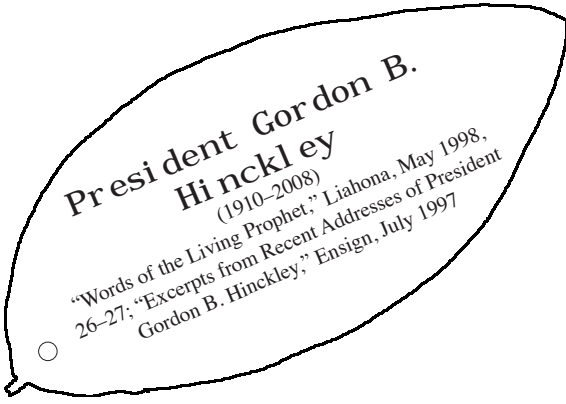
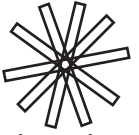

Quote from October 2009 Visiting Teaching Message



Instructions:

1. Print on Orange cardstock. Cut 5 strips. 1"x11" and Leaves (from green paper).
 2. Make a small hole in the center of all of the strips, at the ends of the strips and on the leaves where marked.
 3. Lay leaves and then each strip on top of each other with the text facing down/out.
 4. Poke a brad through the center holes in the leaves and strips, & flatten the legs of the brad to hold the strips in place.
 5. Fan the strips out in a circle. Like this >
 6. Curve the strips up, one by one, and poke the second brad through the hole at the end of each strip forming the top, going in order around the pumpkin (the last couple might be a little tricky), flatten the legs of the second brad to secure.
- Optional:* Use a little strip of green for the stem or brown ribbon if desired.
